<u>Everything should</u> be out by 6am.

Pick up is delayed one day if a designated holiday falls within the week—CodeRed calls will be sent. Casella will pick up 1 (one) Casella toter GARBAGE from each residence each week. Should you produce more than (one) 1 toter of GARBAGE per week arrangements can be made with **CASELLA** to rent extra toters for a yearly fee. Since the Village of North Collins has our own yard waste pickup, Casella will not pick up yard waste of any kind. Casella will also pick up two (2)

BULK items such as furniture or mattresses each week; as well as two (2) white items such as household appliances each week. All bulk items must be under 80 pounds. Furnaces will not be picked up nor will items that contain Freon (refrigerators, humidifiers, air conditioners, etc.)

It is labeled Casella Garbage and Recycling Tips.

There is no limit to the amount of recycling that can be accepted but please remember that if guidelines are not met, our ability to recycle in the future may be jeopardized. Here are some helpful reminders that will ensure that this valuable service can continue:

- Please break down cardboard boxes. This allows the recycling truck enough room to pick up the entire village in one load.
- The place that takes the recycling, Buffalo Recycling, no longer accepts waxy or glossy cardboard items. (Juice cartons come to mind and some of the soda containers are waxy/glossy)
- All containers should be rinsed out as thoroughly as possible. If there are still chunks of peanut butter or mayo or salsa or whatever in the glass or plastic containers then they get rejected as trash. Since we do zero sort, one container of PB with stuff still in it could reject the entire load. No one wants to see that happen because that raises the rates for everyone.
- Pizza boxes must be grease free. Greasy box bottoms should be put in the trash and the top of the box can be recycled. Take and bake pizza boxes are acceptable for recycling as long as the plastic wrap goes in the trash.
- Lids/caps on glass or plastic bottles and jars are NOT recyclable. Since they contain materials that are not recyclable, the lids/caps must go in the garbage.

RECYCLING GREATLY REDUCES THE AMOUNT OF WASTE IN THE GARBAGE TOTERS. THERE IS UNLIMITED RECYCLING SO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS TO HELP KEEP YOUR TAXES LOWER AND REDUCE OUR LANDFILL WASTE.
